### **Pennswood Art Gallery Opens Erin Endicott Mixed Media Retrospect with Wine & Cheese Reception on January 15**



*January 3, 2012. Newtown, PA:* **On Sunday, January 15, a retrospective exhibit of mixed media works by [Erin Endicott](#) will open with a wine and cheese reception from 3:00 to 5:00 p.m. at the Pennswood Art Gallery, located in Pennswood Village, a continuing Care Retirement Community, at 1382 Newtown-Langhorne Road, in Newtown, PA.** This event is open and free to the public. The show, which runs through February 26, is open daily from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

This exhibit will show the progression of Endicott's work over the years through the use of a variety of mediums and combinations ranging from inks, watercolors, drawing, weaving, embroidery, beading, etc. exploring and expressing her inner landscape. However much the mediums changed, her work has always been autobiographical.

Endicott, a graduate of Moore College of Art, says her pieces reflect the complexities and layering of life, that her process is metaphorical and strives to create more than the sum of its parts. Her latest series of work, "Healing Sutras," is created on vintage fabric passed down from women in her family. The pieces show the many patterns, behaviors and wounds seeded into our psyche at birth growing slowly, organically into our lives. The meditative process of stitching starts the real healing by bringing these areas into the light.

Endicott's work has been and is being shown and collected worldwide ranging from New York City to the Netherlands to Australia and across the U.S.A.
